

GMO/OP MILITARY UNIQUE CURRICULUM

The charter of the GMO/OP Military Unique Curriculum subject matter expert panel was to identify the General Medical Officer (GMO) relevant subjects, which are either truly military unique or disproportionately encountered in the deployed environment. As such, most conditions commonly encountered by a GMO are not listed. However, the consensus of the GMO/OP panel was that most practitioners at the end of the GME-1 year are relatively inexperienced in the diagnosis and management of common problems associated with women's health issues, dentistry, psychiatry, and orthopedics in a conventional setting, let alone in an austere operational environment. The general knowledge and experience levels within the following recommended clinical areas needs to be enhanced.
